



## REGULATIONS FOR A MASS EVENT.

For the duration of the mass event:

**European Beach Volleyball Championships – CEV EuroBeachVolley 2026 Warmia Mazury (the "Event")**

on 12–16 August 2026, the following Regulations shall apply to all its participants.

These Regulations (hereinafter: the "Regulations") were issued on the basis of the Act of 20 March 2009 on the Safety of Mass Events (consolidated text Dz. U. z 2017 r., poz. 1160 as amended; „Ustawa o bezpieczeństwie imprez masowych”).

### § 1 Definitions

The terms used in the Regulations mean:

- 1) "Event" – the mass event 'European Beach Volleyball Championships – CEV EuroBeachVolley 2026 Warmia Mazury', taking place on 12–16 August 2026 at the Anders Hotel beach in Stare Jabłonki.
- 2) "Event Area" – the area of the court and the stands around Court No. 1, as well as other zones to which entry is granted on the basis of the entitlements arising from the type of Ticket/Pass.
- 3) "Participant" – a natural person staying within the Event Area on the basis of a valid Ticket, Pass, Entry Pass, VIP Package or another admission document issued by the Organizer.
- 4) "Ticket" – a document entitling the holder to a one-time entry to the Event on the specific day indicated on the Ticket.
- 5) "Pass" – a document entitling the holder to enter the Event on all days of its duration, in accordance with the information on the Pass.
- 6) "Entry Pass" – a document entitling the holder solely to enter the fan zone located outside the stands of the main court, in accordance with the Organizer's information.
- 7) "VIP Package" – a document entitling the holder to enter the VIP zone and to use additional benefits indicated by the Organizer in the information materials.
- 8) "Organizer" – Fundacja MAZURSKIE KLIMATY with its registered office in Stare Jabłonki, ul. Spacerowa 2, 14-133 Stare Jabłonki.

### § 2 General provisions and tickets

1. The Organizer is responsible for the safety of the mass event at the place and time of its duration.
2. The Organizer of the Event is Fundacja MAZURSKIE KLIMATY, ul. Spacerowa 2, 14-133 Stare Jabłonki.
3. The Event takes place at the Anders Hotel beach, ul. Spacerowa 2, 14-133 Stare Jabłonki (the hotel beach). The area of the mass event is the area of the court and the stands for spectators around Court No. 1.
4. Admission to the Event is paid.
5. Admission to the Event is available to Participants holding a valid Ticket, Pass, Entry Pass or VIP Package, purchased at authorized points of sale, in particular via the eBilet.pl service or other channels indicated by the Organizer.
6. The types of admission documents for the Event include, in particular: single-day tickets for specific days of the Event, a Pass for all days of the Event, an Entry Pass to the fan zone and a VIP Package for the entire duration of the Event. The detailed scope of entitlements for each type of admission document is specified by the Organizer in the information materials concerning sales.
7. Purchase of a Ticket/Pass/Entry Pass/VIP Package via the eBilet.pl service constitutes acceptance of these Regulations and of the regulations on the provision of services and sale of tickets by eBilet.pl. With regard to the purchase, payment, returns and complaints concerning tickets, the provisions of the eBilet.pl regulations apply.
8. The Ticket, Pass, Entry Pass and VIP Package are subject to one-time verification upon first entry to the Event Area and may be exchanged for an identifier (e.g., a wristband) entitling the holder to continue to remain within the Event Area. Only a person holding a valid identifier has the right to remain within the Event Area.



9. It is prohibited to make available, resell at a price higher than face value, forge, alter or copy Tickets, Passes, Entry Passes and VIP Packages. Admission documents acquired in breach of these Regulations or of the eBilet.pl regulations may be invalidated without the right to a refund of the price.

10. The Participant is obliged to keep the Ticket/Pass/Entry Pass/VIP Package and the identifier (wristband) for the entire time of staying within the Event Area and to present them at any request of the security services or the Organizer.

### **§ 3 Rules for the participation of minors**

1. Children under 16 years of age may remain within the Event Area only under the constant care of an adult guardian holding a valid admission document. The guardian bears full responsibility for the safety and behaviour of the minor within the Event Area.

2. A Participant who is a minor and has reached 16 years of age may remain within the Event Area unaccompanied, provided that they hold a valid admission document and have the consent of a legal representative/legal guardian, in accordance with applicable law.

3. Children under 3 years of age (born after 12.08.2023) may enter the Event Area free of charge, without the right to a separate seat, only under the care of an adult guardian.

### **§ 4 Participants with disabilities**

1. The Organizer provides a limited pool of places within the Event Area intended for Participants with disabilities, including wheelchair users. The number of such places is limited by safety considerations and the infrastructural possibilities of the Event Area.

2. A person supporting a Participant with a disability is entitled to free entry to the Event Area, provided that such entry applies only together with the person they support and that there is no more than one supporting person per Participant with a disability.

3. Detailed rules for reserving places for Participants with disabilities and for the method of collecting admission documents are specified by the Organizer in the information posted on [www.ebv2026.pl](http://www.ebv2026.pl) and/or in sales communications.

### **§ 5 Rules of conduct within the Event Area**

1. A Participant staying within the Event Area must not create a risk to the life and health of other spectators under the threat of being removed from the Event Area.

2. Persons participating in the Event are obliged to behave in a manner that does not endanger the safety of other persons present at this Event, to comply with the provisions of these Regulations, and in particular to observe the prohibition of:

- a. possessing, bringing in and consuming alcoholic beverages within the Event Area,
- b. possessing and bringing in tools that may pose a threat to the safety of other Participants of the Event, including poles, selfie sticks, etc.,
- c. possessing and bringing in pyrotechnic materials; bringing in intoxicants and psychotropic substances,
- d. bringing in and using professional image and sound recording devices as well as lasers and other devices emitting light,
- e. possessing and bringing in any liquids and beverages in glass containers, metal cans and plastic packaging which, if used contrary to their intended purpose, may pose a risk to human life or health,
- f. climbing over or passing through fences, palisades, barriers,
- g. entering areas not intended for spectators,
- h. throwing any objects,
- i. conducting any commercial activity not agreed with the Organizer,
- j. using items of clothing or an object to cover the face in order to prevent or hinder identification,
- k. proclaiming and displaying slogans with obscene, vulgar and racist content, calling for strife on national, religious, social grounds, etc.,
- l. bringing in other prohibited items included in the list of prohibited items.



The above list is not exhaustive. In case of doubts as to an item brought into the Event Area, the appropriate member of the information and security services (Security) is responsible for determining prohibited and permitted items.

### **§ 6 Image, recording and personal data**

1. The Organizer informs that the course of the Event may be photographed, filmed, recorded by the Organizer and/or other designated third parties, including transmitted live or replayed via video screens and other methods of data transmission and recording, in photographic form or via other current and/or future media technologies.

2. Persons present at the Event may not record, use or transmit the sound or image of the Event (as well as the result and/or statistics) for any purpose other than exclusively private use. It is forbidden to disseminate via the internet, radio, television or via other current or future media, the sound, image, photographs, data, descriptions, recordings, result or statistics from the Event in whole or in part, or to assist another person/other persons in such activities.

3. The Participant of the Event acknowledges that the course of the Event may be recorded and disseminated by the Organizer or entities acting at its request in the form of photographs and audio-video recordings, in particular for the purpose of documenting the course of the Event, ensuring safety, and for the Organizer's promotional and marketing purposes.

4. The controller of Participants' personal data is the Organizer – Fundacja MAZURSKIE KLIMATY with its registered office in Stare Jabłonki. Information on the rules for processing personal data, including Participants' rights, is available in the GDPR information clause posted on the websitej [www.ebv2026.pl](http://www.ebv2026.pl).

### **§ 7 Security services and control**

1. The Organizer's security services – security employees holding appropriate identifiers – have the right to:

- a. check IDs in order to establish identity,
- b. inspect the contents of baggage and clothing, in the event of suspicion that such persons are bringing in or possessing items referred to in § 5 of the Regulations.

2. The Participant of the Event is obliged to comply with the recommendations of the Security Employees and the Organizer.

3. The Organizer's security services have the right to refuse entry to the Event or to remove from the Event Area persons who do not comply with these Regulations, and in particularly dangerous cases to detain and hand them over to the Police.

### **§ 8 Participants' responsibility**

1. Participants of the Event are obliged to observe the principles of respect for public property, respect for greenery, and not to litter the area.

2. Participants of the Event are obliged to strictly follow the indications and orders of the Organizer's security services and the persons responsible for the Event.

3. Such orders may concern:

- a. leaving the Event Area due to a threat that has arisen, together with indicating the manner of conduct – reminding of the nearest exits from the Event Area,
- b. behaving in a strictly defined manner guaranteeing the safety of the participants of the Event; refusal of entry to places within the Event Area that are not intended for the public, in particular rooms and technical-storage areas, office areas and other areas related to the organization of the Event, such as: technical facilities, sound control position, production back-of-house of the Event, etc.

4. The following persons have no right to enter the Event Area:

- a. persons entered in the register of persons who have been banned from entering mass events,
- b. persons bringing alcohol, glass bottles, intoxicants, psychotropic substances, pyrotechnic or explosive articles, or other dangerous items and tools, including weapons,
- c. persons refusing to have baggage or clothing inspected in the event of suspicion that they are bringing the aforementioned items into the area,



- d. persons refusing to present a credible identity document equipped with a photograph and an address,
- e. persons whose identification from the photograph placed in the document is hindered.
5. Participants of the Event may be exposed to continuous presence within a sphere of high sound levels that may cause hearing damage.
6. The Participant has the obligation to inform the Organizer or Security Employees of situations that threaten human life or property.
7. The Participant has the obligation to inform the Security Employees of fires or outbreaks of fire noticed.
8. The Organizer is not responsible for items left within the mass event area.
9. The Organizer has the right to refuse entry to the Event Area to persons who are intoxicated, show signs of alcohol consumption, or are under the influence of narcotics and other intoxicants.

### **§ 9 Changes to the programme, cancellation of the Event and force majeure**

1. The Organizer reserves the right to change the programme of the Event, including the schedule of matches, the order of their playing, starting times, the composition of participating teams/players and accompanying attractions, for important reasons, in particular due to the safety of Participants, decisions of competent authorities, weather conditions or other circumstances independent of the Organizer. A change to the programme of the Event does not constitute grounds for a refund of the price of the Ticket/Pass, unless otherwise results from mandatory provisions of law or the ticket sales regulations.
2. The Organizer may cancel the Event, interrupt it or temporarily suspend its course in the event of the occurrence of circumstances of force majeure, understood as an external event, impossible to foresee and prevent, in particular: extreme weather conditions, natural disasters, decisions of public authorities, threats to the safety or health of Participants.
3. In the event of cancellation of the Event or part thereof for reasons attributable to the Organizer, the rules for any refund of the price of Tickets/Passes/Entry Passes/VIP Packages shall be determined in accordance with applicable provisions of law and the regulations of the eBilet.pl service, and information in this respect shall be provided via the website [www.ebv2026.pl](http://www.ebv2026.pl) and/or the communication channels of ticket sales intermediaries.

### **§ 10 Organizer's responsibility**

1. The Organizer is not responsible for damage arising as a result of force majeure, acts or omissions of third parties for which it is not responsible, or events resulting from Participants' breach of these Regulations or of the law.
2. In the event of cancellation of the Event or part thereof for reasons beyond the Organizer's control, the Participant is not entitled to any compensation or damages, apart from a possible refund of the ticket price under the applicable provisions of law and the regulations of the eBilet.pl service.

### **§ 11 Final provisions**

1. The above Regulations are posted at the entrance to the mass event area.
2. In the event of contentious matters not regulated by these Regulations, decisions are made by the Organizer or the Organizer's security service.
3. Failure to comply with the above Regulations will cause consequences as specified in the e Act of 20 March 2009 on the Safety of Mass Events (consolidated text Dz. U. z 2017 r., poz. 1160 as amended; „Ustawa o bezpieczeństwie imprez masowych”).
4. The Regulations of the Event will be made available to all participants of the Event at the time of entry to the mass event venue by posting them at the entrance gates.
